

CALENDAR TINNING..

Is a finished metal edge on calendars, displays, maps, charts and other printed material, it prevents corners and edges from curling and allows the printed sheet to hang flat.

Tin Colors:

Black
Gold
Gray
Red
White
Blue

Tin Sizes:

6" wide up to 30" wide
Maximum sheet length 40"
Single or multiple PVC eyelets
100# Gloss text up to 12pt

Glossary of Terms

Calendar tin or slide: V-shaped colored metal strip.

Tin Wrap: The amount of paper that is folded up into the tin.

Eyelet: Single or double PVC eyelet that is attached to metal tin, used to hang a calendar, display or chart.

Plain Tin: Metal tin that is used to finish the bottom of a calendar, display or chart, allowing it to hang straight and flat.
